

Dear Parents and Students of the Europagymnasium Auhof,

Since lessons will begin again with distance learning for everyone after the Christmas holidays, I would like to give you some information.

- For the lower grades there is again the offer of supervision at the school. I ask the parents to write a short email with the name of the student, class and day of care to: betreuung@europagym.at if they want to take advantage of this.

If laptops and iPads are needed by the school, as they were in the 2nd lockdown, they will be in the secretary's office on January 4th and 5th between 7:30 am and 12:00 pm and from January 7th during normal secretarial hours (7:30 a.m. - 2:00 p.m.).

- The request for more structure and a better overview in distance learning was fulfilled, and we are starting with an adapted system of distance learning for the first to fifth grades. In every class course there is a distance learning timetable on Eduvidual, which gives a good overview of the tasks of the week according to the timetable. The explanation for the students will follow soon on the homepage.

- Lessons for the lower grades are scheduled from 7th to 15th January in distance learning and no tests or examinations may take place during this time. The same period applies to the upper grades, however, the students are allowed to attend the school face-to-face for preparatory lessons, examinations and tests.

- The lecture about the correct entry of a topic in the VWA database will take place online second period on January 8th for the 7ABF and fourth period for the 8LM.

I think I speak on everyone's behalf when I say that we all long for the end of the pandemic. Until then, I thank you for your cooperation and understanding. The school community and society as a whole are very much challenged by this. Students, parents and teachers are doing their part well to get through this difficult time. I wish you all a time of rest and relaxation and a happy, healthy New Year 2021!
