

Agreement on the Use of Devices according to the Behavior Agreement

*The parts in blue italics are **only** valid for the lower grades.* All other sections apply to all students.

- *Europagymnasium Auhof participates in the device initiative as part of the 8-point plan for the digitalization of Austrian schools. The device acquired as part of this initiative is used in class but can also be used privately.* In order to ensure **responsible** and **conflict-free** use of the device, students must adhere to the rules described in this user agreement.
- The devices **may only be used at school for school purposes**. In particular, the use of non-educational programs at school is not tolerated. For example, no **computer games** may be played, **videos** streamed, or YouTube or other Internet platforms used at school unless they are for school purposes. *Streaming music via internet platforms such as Spotify is not permitted either.*
- Devices may **only be used during lesson times** and on the instructions of the teacher. At all other times, the devices must be stored safely. *Lockable charging cabinets are available for this purpose in the respective classroom.*
- Your own tablet and those of your classmates are **handled with care and attention**. Students may not use other devices without being asked.
- The device must have sufficient **power reserves** during lessons. To this end, students must ensure that the devices are always brought to school with a charged battery. *Only the charging cabinets should be used for charging at school.*
- Students must always ensure **that there is always enough free storage space available** on the device for schoolwork. Otherwise, private apps and data must be deleted immediately.
- **Photo, film and audio recordings** are only permitted on school premises **with the permission** of a teacher and for school purposes.
- Content that is racist, pornographic, glorifies violence, is anti-constitutional, defamatory or not age-appropriate has no place in our school community. Photos, films, music, apps and other media containing such content may not be stored on the device, used, sent or made available to others. If such content is inadvertently accessed during internet research, this must be reported to the teacher immediately.
- Access data such as password or PIN **are confidential** and must not be passed on to third parties. Students are responsible for the security of their device and their accounts.
- Since the devices are not insured, insurance against theft and unintentional damage must be taken out by parents or guardians if necessary.
